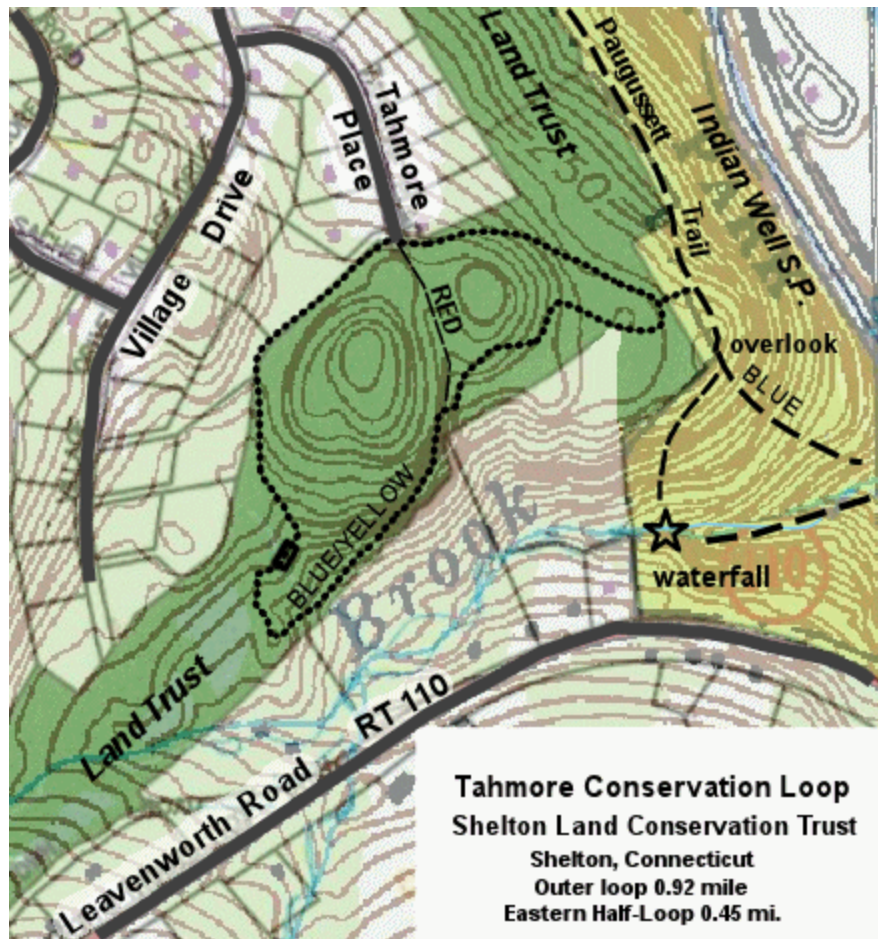


## Tahmore Trail – White Hills



Tahmore Trail is located on property privately owned by the Shelton Land Conservation Trust, not to be confused with the City of Shelton Conservation Commission. The Land Trust holds 364 acres of open space. These lands are privately-owned, but open to the public. See [sheltonlandtrust.org](http://sheltonlandtrust.org) for more information.

Along with the Paugussett Trail, the Tahmore loop is part of the official state “Blue-Blazed” trail system maintained by the Connecticut Forest and Parks Association (CFPA), and is therefore blazed blue-yellow. This trail is rated moderate in difficulty, with a few short somewhat steep sections that may be slippery with fallen leaves. The unblazed spur to the waterfalls shown on the map is not recommended because it is very steep.
